

**ADDENDUM TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #HSA10-11SER08 FOR
GENERATOR PROJECT DESIGN AND CONSULTANCY SERVICES**

ANSWERS TO QUESTION SUBMITTED ON 18TH FEBRUARY 2011

1. Will the HSA review shop drawings or are shop drawings to be reviewed by consultant?

ANS: HSA will review the shop drawings

2. Will the Authority require a minimum number of meetings during the design stage?

ANS: HSA does have a minimum number of meetings

3. Is there a requirement for work permits for the professionals working on this project and if so who is responsible for obtaining and paying for the work permits?

*ANS: Yes, there are work permit requirements for non-resident professionals.
The consultancy company will be responsible for all aspects of acquiring
the work permits, including submission of paperwork and paying all fees.*

4. Can the costs for per diem, hotels, transportation and other travel related items be treated as reimbursable or will the HSA make arrangements and pay with vouchers to the local providers?


ANS: Proposal MUST be inclusive of all travel and per diem.

5. The statement under TIMEFRAME on page 18 “the proposed schedule that completes the appraisal as soon as possible” is unclear; can this statement be clarified?

*ANS: The statement under “TIMEFRAME” means that the schedule submitted in the
proposal should be for the design work to be completed within six (6) weeks of the
commencement of the awarded contract.*

6. Is there a demand type meter at the Hospital at this time?

*ANS: HSA has energy data that will be handed over to the consultancy company who is
awarded the contract.*
